***To get to Gosford High School***

Gosford Train Station is approximately 7 minutes away by foot from Gosford High School. Once you have entered the school carpark, take the first left and walk down towards the Library away from the main street where you entered in Racecourse Road. The gate outside the library and immediately opposite the side entrance to the school hall will be open. The Languages Block is about 30 metres away.
