

2019 Speaking skills day at SCEGGS - Sat 22nd June

This year a Speaking Skills Day for French (Continuers & Extension) students will be held at SCEGGS Darlinghurst, 215 Forbes Street, DARLINGHURST.

Cost: <u>\$25.00 for Continuers only</u> and <u>\$40.00 for Extension</u>. (NOTE: this includes the cost for Continuers)

Payment MUST be made in advance by cheque payable to NAFT, via electronic transfer to the NAFT account or via PayPal on the NAFT website (naft.org.au). CLOSING DATE = Friday 7th **JUNE** Places are limited, so please be early! Please ensure that you have REGISTERED and PAID by the 7th June

Extension teachers will also have to have submitted their topic and written seminar outline that they will present to the students, by this date.

Parking is limited and subject to 2 hours. There is minimal parking available in the school grounds that is accessible without security pass. However, the train at Kings Cross Station is close to the school and Town Hall is about 15 minutes walk. There are also buses on Oxford and William Streets.

At registration :- Students will sign in at Forbes St giving their name, school and mobile number. Continuers Students will receive 2 tickets, one for each Continuers interview, which they hand in to each interviewing teacher. Extension students will receive 3 tickets, 2 as per continuers with the 3rd ticket to be given to the 1st extension session teacher. As they leave, students will sign out.

For Continuers only there will be 2 sessions as follows:-

8.40am	Teachers arrive
9am- 10h15am	Session 1: Essentially for Continuers Only (not extension candidates)
10h15-11h00	Teachers' Morning tea
11h00- 12h15pm:	Session 2 Priority to Continuers staying for Extension

Students book into session 1 OR 2. session 1 or 2.

It is envisaged that <u>Extension students will come for the second session of the Continuers to avoid</u> <u>long waiting times.</u> The teachers of these students will need to be facilitators for the Extension afternoon.

NOTE: We need <u>a ratio of 1 teacher per 7/8 students for both Continuers & Extension</u> <u>sessions</u>

If you have more students than teachers (in the above ratio) and there are other teachers of French at your school, please ask your colleagues to assist as examiners. Otherwise, accommodating large numbers is very difficult. If you have no other colleagues who can help or if you are coming from the country, please let us know your numbers and we will try to garner the help of other members.

If you have NO extension students and are not involved in the Extension Speaking afternoon, just fill in the registration for the Session 1 Continuers Speaking session in the MORNING.

There are no canteen facilities. Teachers and Extension Students are asked to bring their own Lunch.

Morning tea will be provided for teachers with Coffee/Tea and Water in the Staff Room

For Extension the afternoon will run from 1pm-3h15pm. Students and teachers must sign out by the Forbes St gates after the Extension seminars.

Based on the numbers, students will rotate in groups of about 4-5(max) for appox. 40 minutes per rotation to 3 different teachers who will facilitate a **speaking topic** for which the teachers will have **prepared and submitted an outline in advance**.

Each teacher facilitating the Extension afternoon is required to submit TWO TOPICS. If you contributed to the Extension Speaking last year you may 'RECYCLE' ONE of those questions (suitable for 2014-2018 syllabus) PLUS make a new one. If you are participating in the Extension Speaking for the first time, please submit TWO NEW topics.

<u>The topics will need to be emailed to Judith Vrachnas - Judith Vrachnas@sceggs.nsw.edu.au</u> by 7th June.

This time is needed to avoid overlap of topics and to collate and compile a resource booklet that each participating Extension teacher will receive on the day. Topics should be original and not from the common resources available to everyone. If the topics have not arrived by this date your students will be unable to attend the Extension sessions

Please note- Extension teachers: the aim of each Extension session is to

- (i) brainstorm ideas and useful expressions QUICKLY, and
- (ii) give each student time to prepare and present a monologue
- (iii) you and other students can then give constructive feedback to each student.
- You are not there to instruct about the topic. It's PRACTICE for the STUDENTS.

Some hints for EXTENSION topics

It could be something you have already done in class. Please submit no more than a page of dot points of ideas/content/vocab/expressions/arguments for and/or against etc.

Do not supply the writing box. Some appropriate vocabulary and expressions to the topics to be dealt with on the day are useful. Please include-An introduction Approx 3 main points to support a presentation Potential counter points to the discussion A conclusion

TOPIC: 1 (1 page) GUIDE & OUTLINE FOR TOPIC 1 + TOPIC: 2 (1 page) GUIDE & OUTLINE FOR TOPIC 2

Please NOTE:

For Duty of Care and legal reasons - Unaccompanied students will not be allowed to take part.

This is a most worthwhile morning (& afternoon for Extension) for both students and teachers BUT it is exhausting for staff as they examine almost nonstop for 4 hours and some who bring one or two students give hugely of their time for other teachers who have a big class. Please ensure that your students know that teachers are giving generously of their time on a Saturday. Teachers receive no recompense, other than excellent professional experience and a token of NAFT's thanks, <u>therefore a firm commitment to attend is necessary</u>.
